City of Farmington **9 Mile & Floral Water Main Shutdown**

On **Monday, October 26, 2020** the water main on 9 Mile near Floral will be shut down for a short period of time in order to complete the new water main connection. If you are receiving this notice you will experience a short water outage due to this shut down. The contractor, D'Angelo Brothers, will be completing this work to finish the new water main installation along 9 Mile and Floral.

If your water is out for more than a couple hours, or not back on by 2:00 p.m. the day of this shutdown please contact the contractor and the engineering firm at the number listed below.

There is a possibility that some sediment may be stirred up during the connection process and when the water is turned back on. If your water is cloudy or there is sediment, you may need to flush the water from your water supply by flowing the **cold** water at a laundry tub. You may also need to clean your aerators (screens) at sink faucets, If the problem persists, please contact the engineering firm at the number below so the problem can be assessed.

Please keep children and pets away from the construction operation. Construction activities, and the associated equipment that goes with it, is attractive to small children and can be dangerous. Please keep children away from the equipment, removals, mass grading, underground utility installation, and wet concrete.
