City Manager Murphy said he had been talking to an EV charging station manufacturer/dealer for the last 18 months or longer. The company is Red E Charging, LLC based in Detroit. He has had them out to look at two proposed locations: one on Oakland, just west of Farmington on the south side and one on Grove Street, just south of the Sundquist Pavilion on the west side. He proposed having one station at each location with each station having two charging units. Red E Charging would retain ownership, install the equipment, and maintain the equipment. A draft contract was reviewed and discussed by Council. An amended version will be returned to Council for consideration at the next scheduled Council meeting.
