SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Felonious Assault/CCW:

On 08/25/2025 at approximately 4:30 PM Officers were dispatched to a business in the 24000 Block of Orchard Lake Rd on the report of a FA with a knife. It was reported that a store employee and customer got into a verbal altercation. A witness had called 911 reporting that the customer had a knife in their hand. Officers responded to the area however the disgruntled customer had walked away. Officers checked the area, however, were unable to locate the suspect. The suspect, a 32 YO male was located at an adjacent business the next day and was taken into custody. Officers located several folding knives on the suspect, as well as a pair of brass knuckles. The case has been forwarded to the Oakland County Prosecutor for charges.

Possession of Methamphetamine:

On 08/29/2025 an officer Stopped a vehicle for a moving violation in the area of Grand River and Wilmarth. Upon contacting the driver, a 43 YO male it was discovered his license was suspended. Officers conducted an inventory search of the vehicle and located drug paraphernalia, as well as suspected methamphetamine. The male was arrested for possession of methamphetamine, possession of drug paraphernalia and driving on a suspended license. The case has been forwarded to the detective bureau for warrant submission to the Oakland County Prosecutors Office.
